Fostering is a critical part of rescue, without foster careers many animals die. A Mini Rescue screens all foster careers, we visit all foster careers. Our foster form is invasive, as animal wellbeing is critical to us. All the information you have provided us will be kept in the strictest confidence and used only to support this application.

Fosters of A Mini Rescue will be supported when needed, and you need never to feel alone. Do you understand that many rescue animals come from insecure environments and are likely to be scared, and skittish? It is likely that they will take some time to settle down, grow trust and integrate with your family? Animals coming into foster care may not be in the best health when they arrive, and may need nursing. A foster career in normal circumstances is provide food, safety, security and love to the animals they are fostering.

THE AGREEMENT

The purpose of this application is to ensure that both the animal and potential foster family are matched together. At A Mini Rescue, we are committed to the safety and well-being of our rescued animals. We appreciate that all situations are different and will consider all applications equally. Submission of this application does not guarantee fostering of the stated animal, all applications are carefully reviewed and a decision is provided to the applicant as soon as practicable

I understand that I am entering into a binding agreement between myself and A Mini Rescue for fostering a rescue animal. I confirm that I have read this entire agreement carefully and fully understand all aspects before signing (*Please tick to confirm you understand*).

I agree that this pet is being fostered as a companion pet. That the pet will be provided with proper food, water, shelter, exercise. That the pet will be given a loving home and not be kept solely in the yard without interaction.	
I understand that dogs can chew and may damage some household or personal items, if this occurs I will not seek compensation from A Mini Rescue.	
If the animal is currently under veterinary care, I confirm that I have been notified of any current medical Conditions as far as A Mini Rescue has been made aware and I understand that any veterinary problems that now may arise with this pet, including serious illnesses requiring emergency care or surgery and costs are to be approved by A Mini Rescue	
I understand that in the event that I can no longer foster the animal, due to injury, illness, accident or any other reason and are unable to fully care for the pet, I will notify A Mini Rescue immediately and will work with A Mini Rescue to place the pet in another approved foster home. Only with direct written authority from A Mini Rescue	
Foster careers need to be able to commit to transporting to and from A Mini Rescue partner vet for de-sexing and vaccinations when due.	
I indemnify and hold A Mini Rescue free from any and all liability arising from any and all claims, demands, losses, damages, action, judgment of every kind and description which may occur to or be suffered by me, members of my household, or any third parties by reason of activities arising out of this agreement.	
I understand that sometimes along with a rescue animal there comes a story, I will at all times keep these stories confidential within the team at A Mini Rescue to ensure that no slandering or bad publicity takes place.	
You understand that the pet and any litter it may produce belongs to A mini Rescue and is not theirs to keep or rehome	
That you could be responsible for any vet bills as a result of avoidable accidents or incidents – this will be decided by A Mini Rescue on a case by case	
You are prepared to offer meets and greets to prospective adopters	
I have answered the questions above truthfully and completely. I understand that although A Mini Rescue screens all animals and careers prior to placing, it takes no responsibility for the behaviour, or actions of the animals placed in foster care. I understand that I accept animals from A Mini Rescue at my own risk, and can reject or return to A Mini Rescue any animal they have asked me to care for.
